News from San Pedro, Dominican Republic

'Bringing the Kingdom from Heaven to Earth...'



Three months into the start of my new ministry in the Dominican Republic I am overwhelmed at how God has been working in guiding us through this process. The financial gifts, staff, new friends, appointments with pastors, government officials and people who have stepped up and offered their help, has been incredible.

We have leased an incredible property located just 10 minutes outside of San Pedro in the Juan Dolio hotel district. The property comes with three villas, large pool, parking spaces and open space ideal for outside meetings.



Our official welcome to the city of San Pedro was a Pastors conference entitled 'Disciplining Nations and Communities – Influencing the Seven Spheres of Society'. With Kent Norell, Sean Lambert and Jim

Stier, all seasoned YWAM speakers, we stirred up the pastors with the concepts of bringing the Kingdom from heaven to earth. We also held a breakfast at a local hotel with the mayor, city officials, pastors and the state governor where the benefits of giving land rights to those living on the invaded land was presented.

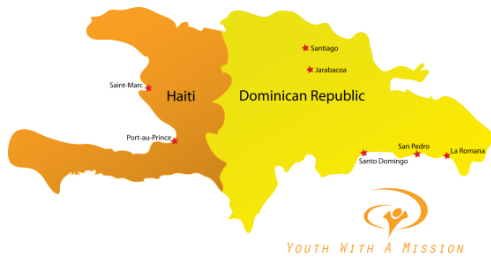


Just two months into the start of our ministry in the Dominican Republic we were hosting our very first teams. A team of 23 students from the DTS in Tijuana, Mexico arrived for a month, followed shortly after by a team of 12 DTS students from Kona, Hawaii. With a mix of assisting us in repairs and additions to the property and with ministry in the Churches of San Pedro Both teams have had a great experience and have blessed our ministry greatly. It is exciting to hear their testimonies of their outreaches and opportunities to minister to people.

Homes of Hope and not Forgetting your Neighbor.

This week we start the process of building our very first Homes of Hope. With this to be a demonstration house of what our program can do, the organization of local pastors has provided us with a pastor's family to be blessed with this first home.



Pastor Juan, earning less than \$70 per week, is leading the people in the one of the poorest neighborhoods of San Pedro. This will be a great start of our Homes of Hope program and gives us the opportunity to demonstrate how God's love can be shown through the construction of a home.



Just a 10 minute walk from our campus places you in a migrant camp or 'invasion' area. The majority of those living there are Haitian and are working on the nearby high rise condo projects. The living conditions are very poor and the children don't have the money to attend school.

Homes of Hope is one of our main tools of ministry but because they are squatters we are not permitted to build them houses. The visiting DTS students prayed and went out in teams. Some picked up

trash, did prayer walks, door to door evangelism and praying for people, others played soccer with the children.

It was a great first day but this community deals with witchcraft, prostitution and darkness. There are two little churches, but there is no unity between them. So as we work with these two Churches and begin ministering here please pray against division and disunity and for LOVE to reign. Love for these poor families and love for the Pastors.
